Sale Conditions

- 1. The Finch Society of Australia Inc. is providing the venue but all transactions are between seller and purchaser.
- 2. The price paid is negotiated solely between seller and purchaser.
- 3. Upon request sellers must supply each purchaser with information containing the seller's name and phone number.
- 4. Upon entry at the venue The Finch Society of Australia Inc. will collect \$1 for each bird entering the sale and \$4 for each person entering the sale.
- 5. There is no refund for birds unable to be sold on the day.
- 6. Sellers must bench all birds prior to 9.30am.
- 7. No birds are to be sold until the sale commences at 10am.
- The sale is run according to the current CCBFA NSW Bird Sales and Auctions Code of Practice. Copies are available at the sale, online at <u>www.ccbfa.org.au</u> or via the QR code below. Recent changes include...
 - a. Maximum 4 birds per cage
 - b. No all-wire cages for finches or quails
 - c. Sellers are not to put birds in inappropriate buyer cages
